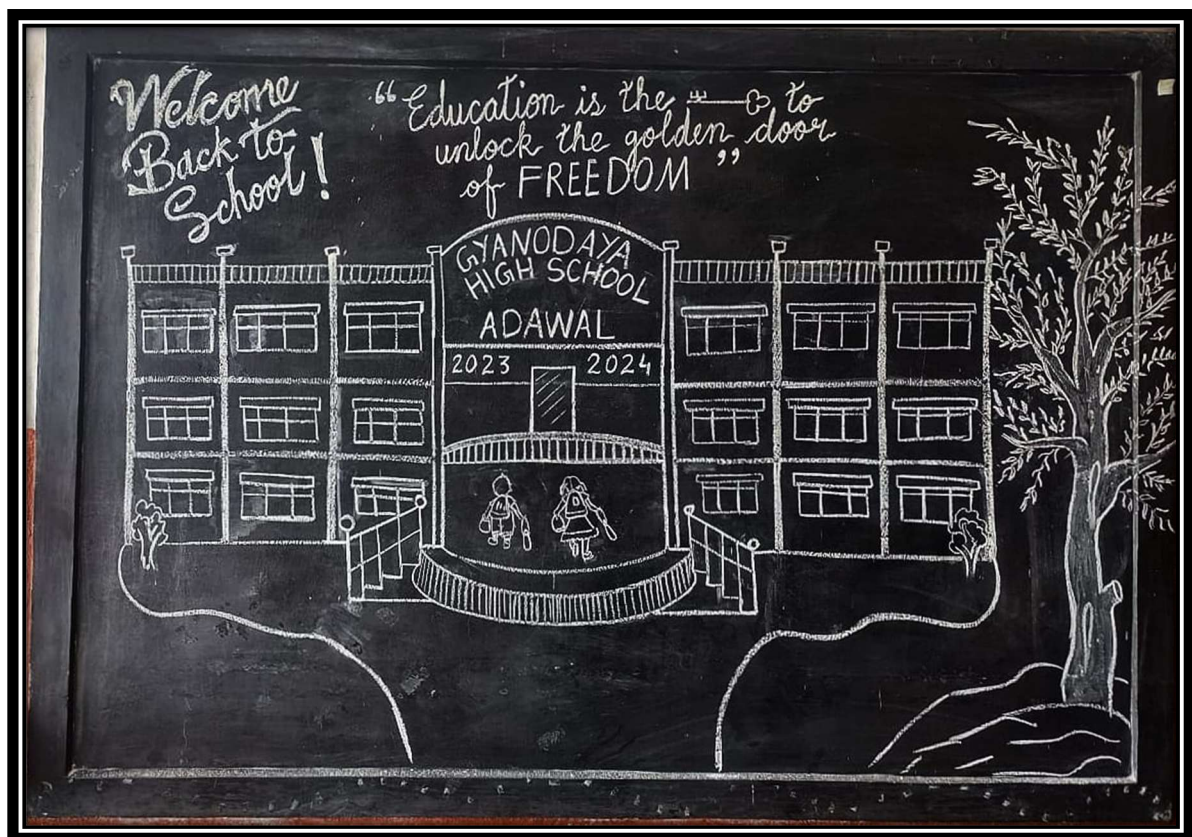

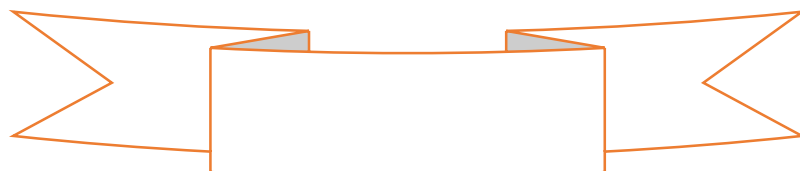

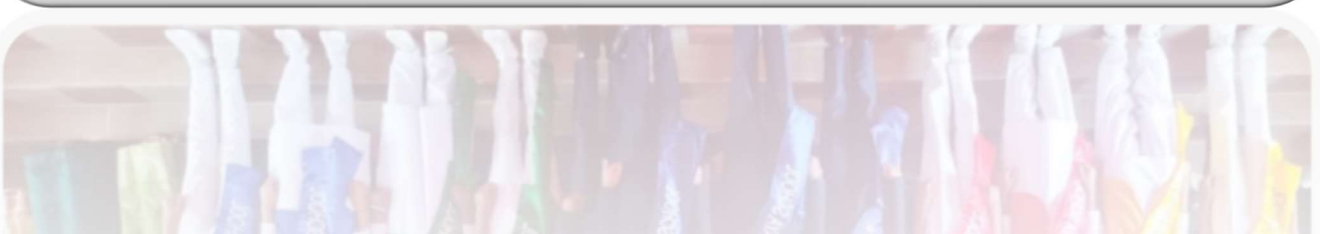

Educational Tour

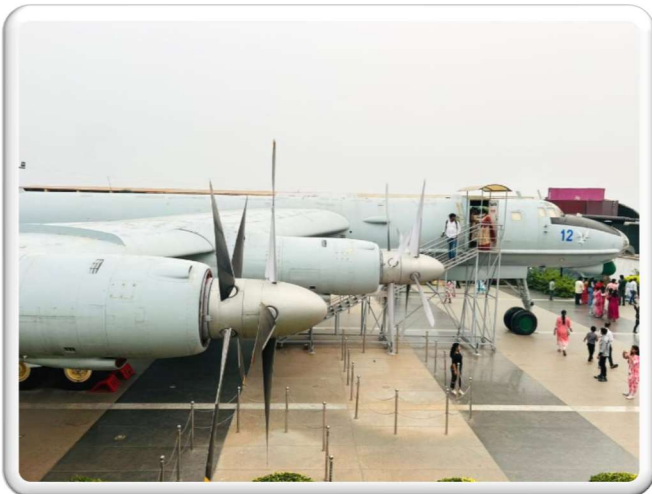
“Travel is like an endless university. You never stop learning.” It's an essential part of the learning process.

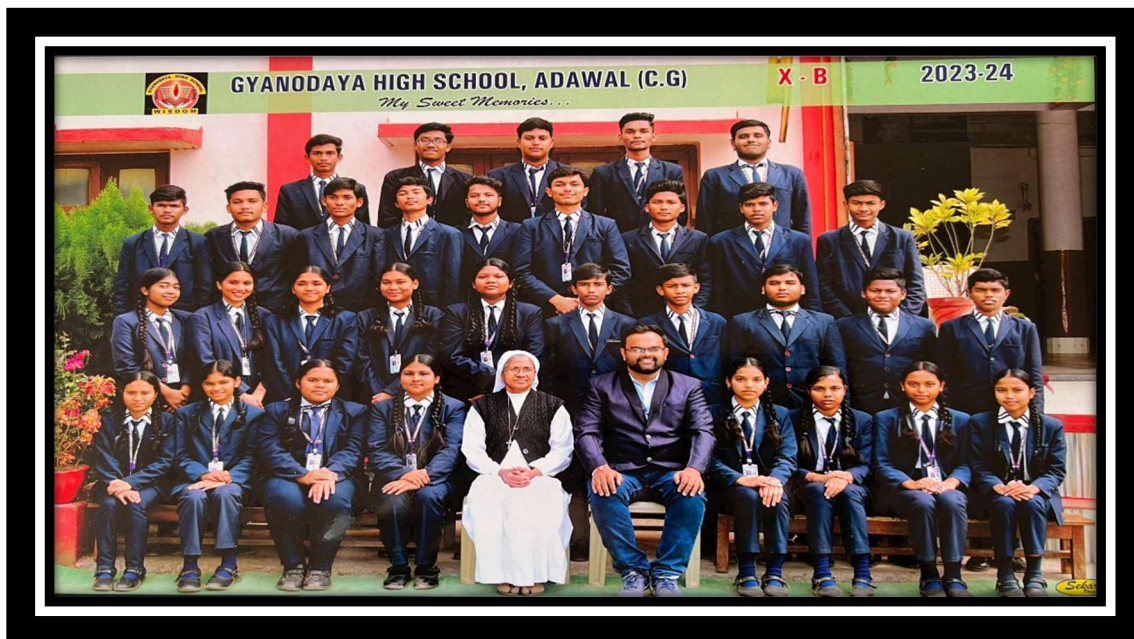
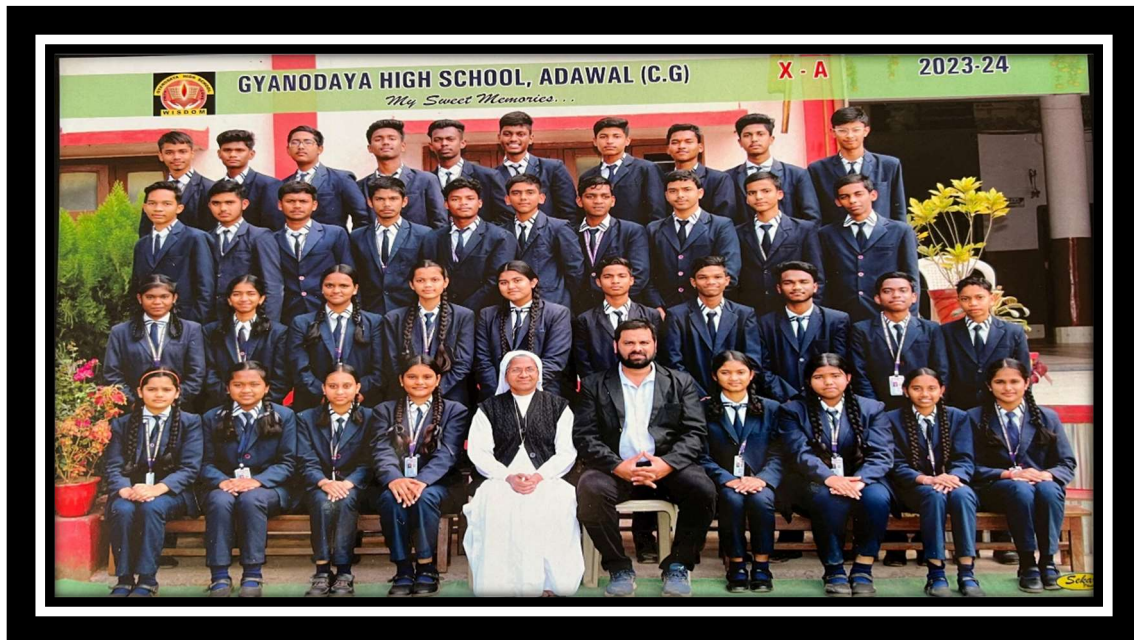

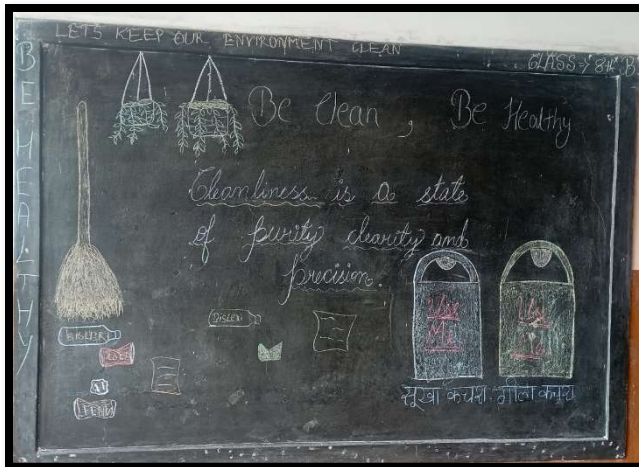
Visit to Asha Ashram
